



ON-DEMAND EMERGENCY MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

Multiple Emergency Medical Response Service providers provide immediate access to a team of dedicated nurses and paramedics, together with a national complement of accredited medical assistance service providers who will assist with a medical emergency.

The services include:

Medical Advice:

The Service Providers will guide clients through a medical crisis, as well as provide clients with emergency advice which includes referrals to crisis lines, doctors, clinics and hospitals in the area.

Advice includes information on:

- Prescription Medication
- Antibiotics
- Contra-indication of medicines
- Why not to take expired medication
- Fevers
- Treatment of abrasions
- Blurred Vision
- Telephonic CPR
- Insomnia
- Ear aches
- Headaches/ Migraines
- Allergies
- Stomach aches
- Women's / Men's Health
- Supplements
- Cramps



Referrals to:

- Closest Medical facilities
- GP's within the client's area
- Closest Medical Transport
- Health Specialists

Medical Transportation:

In the event of a client's involvement in a medical emergency, the Service Provider will arrange and coordinate the most appropriate method of emergency medical transportation.

Clients will be transported to the nearest medical facility capable of providing adequate care. Including transportation by road or air ambulance (dependent on weather conditions and flight plans).
